- Application received from Christine Burton for the Oakville & District Kennel Club to hold a BCC Regional Specialty the weekend of Sept. 9-11, 2016 with a date suggestion of Sept. 10, 2016, in Mississauga, ON.
- Paul W: What happens when both National Specialties are asked to be out west in 20108?.
  - o Dave: There will have to be a vote
- **Bernice**: My question is ... the National was supposed to be split one year one Club out west, Then cannot continue to have a National Specialty every other yr/. The Boxer Club of Can had to split the National between Ontario and the West Coast, so BC should be prepared to split the show with other Western Clubs
  - o **Dave**: The reason this happened this time was that no one had applied for the national out west so Monika wanted to make sure there was a Western national. The Alberta app came in at the last minute.
  - Mary: From the By-Laws: As with the National Specialty, the Regional Specialties will rotate within the Electoral Area unless no other club or member of the Boxer Club of Canada applies to hold the Regional Specialty. Key words - As with the National
  - Jenny: since no one else has applied for a. Reg Spec in our Zone does this mean that the ODKC gets the Reg Spec Sept 10, 2016 as this was announced at last month's meeting?
  - o Dave: Was the application announced at the last meeting
  - Jenny: Yes
  - o Mary Yes Jenny and Monika gets the 2017 Regional for her area

## **New Business:**

- Jenny: can we discuss the possibility of donating a total of \$1,000 divided equally to 4 charities (ex OVC, Boxer Rescue etc).
  - o **Dave**: I think we should wait till we are dine our auction as we have already made one donation to Boxer Rescue and will be doing another one with the next auction

Paul Wilcox	I tought when Paul D. was treasurer the membership voted to cut back on donations
DaveGilmour	It was dealt with anually until we started doing the auctions
Bernice Lanagley	You have had sufficient funds to make a donation to the Rescue etc etc. This is a Non Profit Organization and you are sitting on charitable funds. You should use some of it sometime.
DaveGilmour	Yes we had vioted to cut back on donations but that was part of the objective of the auctions to keep donating to rescue
Bernice Lanagley	Maybe my thinking is wrong but you have the money in the bank.
DaveGilmour	Which charitable funds are you referring to Bernice
Paul Wilcox	Thanks Dave, that was my recollection
Bernice Lanagley	You have Boxer Rescue, both here and Alberta has a large Rescue, you have OVC. You have cholices.
DaveGilmour	The donations have been going to Boxer Rescue canada
Christine Burton	I am unable to scroll back to financial report. What is our current bank balance?
DaveGilmour	Approx 14,000
Bernice Lanagley	\$14727.00 to be exact
Christine Burton	If we have no major expense's perhaps we take a vote to see if membership would like to donate a certain amount of money. Given that we no longer pay for a venue the club may have funds
Marta Nettelfield	Just as an FYI for those that don't know - Boxer Rescue Canada works rescue in BC, AB and SK. As well, we have moved back into the Maritimes to try and build up a volunteer network there.
DaveGilmour	Untill I have a chance to talk with Kim I suggest we don't do anything because some of the funds you are looking at belong to a fund for the 70th club anniversary show next yera
MaryCurl	Two things
MaryCurl	First: I suggest that we come back to the next meeting with numbers re: what is going to the 2017 National (what is in that fund) and also some concrete numbers and charities that we would wish to donate to

- **Richard T:** With this booth in September...will there be any room in the budget to get things to hand out? We will need literature or something. I've tried several times to get some sort of budget to start promoting our club to no avail...
  - Sandra: perhaps if Rick could get a budget for breed publicity we would have less uninformed people getting boxers then sending them to rescue:)
  - Sandra: I would move that Rick get a \$100 for promtional handouts.
  - Seconded by Paul W
  - Carried

- Richard: At this point with membership declining and people's decisions being made from financial points we need not only to
  promote our breed but our club as a whole...alot of people that contact us for a boxer are not even aware there is a national
  club in Canada
  - Dave: I could not agree more Rick. Mary and Richard do we have an existing pamphlet to use or do we need to design one
  - o Mary: There is a pamphlet that was made a few years ago I can try and find it and see if it could be modified to suit
  - Anne: is that a motion Mary?? if so I second
  - o A discussion on procurement and costs and content of pamphlets was held.
  - Dave: Rick How you like to put a committee together of your choosing and get the ball rolling
  - o Richard: Yes we need to get something rolling and I'd appreciate any help I can get
  - Dave: Anybody that would like to help please get in contact with Rick
- Josie: We also need more breed info on the website. We are a paperless society and it will reach a much wider audience
  - Mary: Breed info for the website is good send and I will do. Also send for the public Facebook page
  - Josie: Ok great! Thanks!
- Christine: Pet expo is giving 10 free booths to breed clubs. Should I confirm a booth or wait to see if we can man it?
  - Dave: I think you should confirm it. We will find people to man it one way or another
- **Rick** Pamphlets are good but I've been to trade shows and most end up on the floor or in the recycling...we need something that people will actually keep...like a fridge magnet or something like that
  - o Dave what are we looking at for items like that Rick
  - Summer Exactly Rick...or a pen with our website on it
  - o Rick Something people will keep and will subconsciously urge them to keep going back to our website
  - Josie Paper doesn't work anymore....
  - Rick I will look into it...once again Vista print has so many things to choose from
  - o Dave I like the fridge magnet idea
  - o **Bracchetti** Totally Rick and Josie!!
  - o Shawn Pens are a good idea as well
  - o Rick Maybe even BCC clothing for whomever pulls a shift at the booth...it makes a more professional impression
  - o **Anne** pens are cheap, could do both
  - o **Bracchetti** Vistaprint is great
  - Dave Sounds like we have a lot of good ideas. People please talk to Rick because the more people involved the lighter the load on any one individual
  - Dave I agree Rick. Jenny can you find out what we would be looking at price wise for some golf shirts for the volunteers
  - o Jenny sure will anything else you want us to get prices on--- quantities???
  - o Dave I guess it depends on how many volunteers we get
