Reading of General Correspondence: Cindy Thomas

- Cindy: I have received two applications.
 - First application received on January 22, 2013, from Mary Curl on behalf of the Boxer Club Of Canada Inc. to host the 2015 BCC National. There is no specific date or location listed.
 - Second application received on February 2, 2013, from Christine Burton on behalf of the Oakville & District Kennel Club to host the 2015 National on either Sept. 12th or 13th in Ancaster, Ontario.
 - Please note that other clubs have 30 days to get an application in before a vote will take place. For those who
 submitted the application please make sure you attend the next meeting so that you can present any further
 information and answer any questions prior to the vote.

Old Business:

- Jack: Just for information we have Christian Gomez from Colombia (working dog specialist) judging the regional and Gloria Geringer, one time boxer owner handler now an AKC judge, judging the BCOWO speciality in Oct in London. 5 sets of points over 3 days
- Mary: The Boxer Club of Canada now has a calendar on its pages go to the BCC page and type /calendar.html in the
 address bar after the bcc address. All Boxer Clubs are welcome to send us info on shows and we will add them to the
 calendar including closing dates if we have them. Or click the link on the main page

 - Jenny: are we also listing any all breed clubs that have a Reg or Nat Spec here for the members?
 - Mary: Yes listing regionals any boxer specialty
 - Cindy: Can we list health clinics as well?

- o Mary: Yes
- **Dave:** I think the calendar will be a good tool for the club
- Irene: this is old business Black Boxers. I have been working with Leila Bahari, Registration Division, CKC, there is no such genetic make-up or combination to produce a black a black Boxer. It is up to the Boxer Club of Canada to reconize the proper coloring for a Boxer. If their parents are registered the pups of any standard color are eligible to for registration. The so called black Boxer is a reverse brindle. I have checked two in the last two months and they have had fawn stripe on their belly. Therefore they are a reverse brindle. It only takes one stripe to be a reverse brindle. The proper coloring should be sent to Leila Bahari, Director of Registration that this is a reverse brindle not a black. It is up to CKC to register it as a reverse brindle instead of black. It is up to the Boxer Club to make it clear that their is not a black boxer.
- I have taken genetics and taught genetics, there is no such genetic numbers in the genetic pool, in the Boxer pool, to produce a black Boxer. The Boxer Club has to eliminate black in the breed standard and call it a reverse brindle because it only takes one fawn stripe to call it a brindle. I told Dave this a long time ago.
 - o Sandra: has the CKC registered blacks
 - o **Dave**: To my knowledge not in recent times.
 - Sandra: thank you Irene for this info, does this now mean that they will not register blacks?
 - o Jack: At some shows when color is in question dogs are taken outside. Where in fact one strip of brindle anywhere is
 - Mary: What does the CKC need from us Irene
 - o Irene: it has to be in the Boxer standard as there is no such thing as a black
 - Sandra: perhaps we could strike a committee, given this valuable information, to come up with a proposal to send to the CKC.
 - while we're at it, perhaps we could strike a committee to deal with the new health screening in the master breeder programme
 - Mary: Good idea are you up on all that Sandra? Could you get a committee together?
 - Dave: It is already under discussion at the exec level but we ran out of time at the meeting
 - Sandra: I feel strongly about the health screening issue, so am willing to do what I can. I am more than
 happy to be on a committee for the colour issue, but not a geneticist
 - Irene: CKC does not seem to know that Black is not in our standard and novice breeders would not know they would just call it black. It is up to CKC to call it a reverse brindle. The two dogs I checked, their breeder called the color black and both had one fawn strip, one on the belly and one was on inside of the hind leg therefore I would have call them reverse brindles. It only takes one strip to be a brindle.

More discussion was held

Sandra: I move that we strike an adhock committee to look into the CKC colour registration issue and report back to the next meeting with their recommendations

Cindy seconded.

- Dave: Would you head it Sandra
- Sandra: yes, but want Irene on committee

Folks we have a motion on the floor. Those opposed please say no One no vote – Motion Carried

Dave: Irene will you be on the color comittee with Sandra. Also can we have any other volunteers?

Irene: Yes but not a short time as we are going to Hawiia for three weeks.

Sandra: I'll send an e-mail to the BCC group for volunteers

New Business:

 - This year's All About Pets Show is taking place March 29 31, 2013 at the International Centre in Mississauga, Ontario. There will be lots of families looking for activities to do together on this long weekend, and the All About Pets Show is an ideal opportunity for you to showcase your breed and breed club to this audience! A good opportunity to educate the public on what is a Boxer and what is a GOOD breeder!
