I have been involved in show dogs since 1970 when I started breeding and showing Boxers. I finished many Boxers out of my breeding with the Ber-Beu's prefix and with my wife, Terry, under the Dante's prefix. I became a professional handler in 1978 and finished many Boxers until the end of 1993. I campaigned top specials like Ch. Vancroft's Primetime (ABC national specialty BIS 1999), Ch. Rummer Run's My Girl, Ch. Turo's Dakota of Shar-Rea, Ch. Rummer Run's Mary Jane, etc. I showed other breeds in working, hound, sporting, toy and nonsporting. However, my heart and devotion has always been with Boxers.

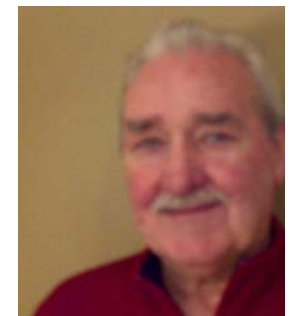
I started judging in 1997 and have judged the American Boxer Club National Specialty twice, American Boxer Club regional; American Boxer Club Top 20; 2 Boxer Nationals in Mexico; Boxer National in Canada; Boxer National in Argentina; Specialty in Brazil; as well as many specialties throughout the United States. Throughout the USA I have judged specialties in other breeds, all breed and rare breed shows.

I currently judge the working and hound groups and part of the sporting group as well as Best in Show and Juniors.

I am a Lifetime member of the American Boxer Club.

OUR SWEEPSTAKES JUDGE

JIM McGRISKIN



I have been breeding and showing Boxers for over 40 years. I purchased my first boxer Can. Ch. Jocolu's Charming Fashion, DOM, at 6 months of age in June 1968, from Mike Milan, owner breeder of the famous Int. Ch. Milan's Fashion Hint. After much persuasion, Mike talked me into showing my new girl Charm, from that day on I was hooked.

I grew up on a dairy farm, showing cattle through the local dairy club, so the transition to dog showing came easy. I give much credit to my mentor Shirley DeBoer of Scher Khoun Boxers for all her advice and guidance in the early years. Another person that helped me was the late Jean Grant of Blossomlea Boxer kennels.

JUDGES BIOGRAPHIES (cont'd)

In 1970 I registered the kennel name "Aracrest" and my first litter was born in April of that year. This first litter produced 4 Canadian Champions and 3 American Champions. Am. Can. Ch. Aracrest's Jered S.O.M., Am Can. Ch. Aracrest's Kaylib S.O.M., Am. Can. Ch. Aracrest's Trinkett, Can. Ch. Aracrest's Brocade. Jered went on to many B.I.S and B.I.S.S. including 1973 ABC, and 1972 Regional B.O.B. winner.

In 1972. Can. Ch. Aracrest's Amnesty (11 month old) son of Ch Aracrest's Trikett went B.O.W., at the ABC Regionals owner handled. 1973 started off with a bang also when Am. Can. Ch. Aracrests Velvet Sensation went Grand Prize Futurity Winner owner handled.

My breeding has been kept to a minimum, I will breed occasionally under the prefix of JVM Boxers.

I have been handling all breeds since the 70's in both Canada and the U.S.

For the past 2 years I handled Can & Am Ch Remember Me Last Man Standing to 2 BIS All Breeds and #2 and #3 Boxer in Canada as while completed his American title and Specialty wins.

OUR OBEDIENCE JUDGE

NORMA J SCHAFFER

My life with dogs began early with my father's hunting dogs, a pair of Springer spaniels. Recognizing my interest, a family friend introduced me to the Vancouver Junior Kennel Club where I became involved with obedience training. Education and work took priority for a few years, but when the time was right, I acquired a Springer puppy, became involved with obedience training once again and have had one or more Springers in my household ever since. I have trialed my own dogs since 1975 and became an obedience judge in 1988. I am actively involved in tracking, obedience, rally, spaniel hunt tests, and the St. John Ambulance therapy dog program. Presently I share my home with yet another Springer with whom I am enjoying all of these activities and have even ventured into the conformation ring for the first time! I hope that each competitor who enters my ring has a good experience with their dog, regardless of the score they achieve.

DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of this Specialty

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of this Specialty

12 to 15 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 15 mos. on the day of this Specialty

15 to 18 Months Class – This class shall be for dogs at least 15 mos. of age on the day of this Specialty and under 18 mos. on the day of this Specialty

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. (Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN BRINDLE CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs of the brindle colour

OPEN FAWN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs of the fawn colour

VETERANS CLASS – This class shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of this Specialty. ***(This class will be divided into 3 age divisions – 7 to 9 yrs, 10 & 11 yrs and 12+ yrs. Winners of each class will carry through to compete for Best of Breed)***

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for Champions of record at the time of closing of entries for this Specialty. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE FIRST SHOW. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex)

STUD DOG CLASS – This class shall be comprised of the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get. All dogs comprising the get need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Get must be entered in a regular class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – This class shall be comprised of the Brood Bitch and 2 or more of her progeny. All dogs comprising the progeny need not be the property of the same exhibitor. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.

PARADE OF CHAMPIONS/VETERANS– This class shall be for all Boxers who: hold a CKC or AKC Championship and/or hold a CKC or AKC performance title or for those Veteran dogs that are over 7 years of age. Dogs entered in the Parade **MUST** be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition only, spayed and neutered dogs may be entered in the parade. The parade will be held after the completion of Best of Breed judging. ***Please include a short resume of your dog, limited to 50 words or less for publication in the catalogue.***

DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY



TRANSITION OBEDIENCE CLASSES

PRE-NOVICE – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE “C” – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice ‘C’ exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice ‘C’ Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice ‘C’ Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice ‘C’ are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice ‘C’ class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice ‘C’ and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS

*NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE “A” & “B” AT SAME TRIAL
NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN “A” & “B” AT SAME TRIAL*

NOVICE “A” - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of “CD” in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its “UD” title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but **MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE “B” CLASS**

NOVICE “B” - This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of “CD”, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg’d to compete in this class

OPEN “A” - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of “CD” IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of “CDX” in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor **MUST BE THE OWNER** or **A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY** and **MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.** No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its “UD” title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but **MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN “B” CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg’d number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN “B” - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of “CD” in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog **MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS.** A CKC or ERN Reg’d number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS ‘A’ - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of “CDX” but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg’d number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS ‘B’ - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of “CDX” or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.A CKC or ERN Reg’d number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY.

BRACE CLASS - This class is open to any two dogs of the breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. Same person need not own both dogs.

TEAM CLASS - This class is open to any four dogs of the breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. Same person need not own all dogs.

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have not gained a qualifying score toward the "CDX" title in Canada BUT that has obtained the title "CD" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

GRADUATE OPEN CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have not obtained a qualifying score toward the "UD" title in Canada BUT which has obtained the title "CDX" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

VERSATILITY CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have attained the title of "CDX" in Canada and at least 1 leg on the Utility title, or that has obtained the "UD" title in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS
